JORGE R. COQUIA, *THE CHURCH AND STATE LAW IN THE PHILIPPINES* (1959). The Book mainly examines the religious history of the Philippines and how developments in such have contributed to the Philippine way of life. The Author then analyzes, among others, the extent of religious worship and its limitations, the juridical personality of the Church, the jurisdiction of ecclesiastical, and the tax exemption of religious properties and income. Commenting on the Book, a prolific writer describes it as having filled the gap existing in Philippine legal literature. As such, the Book provides for solutions to issues arising from the relations of Church and State.
